## The Bering Glacier Partnership

The BLM, and its partners, share science issues associated with the Bering Glacier that include: 1) evolution of the Bering terminus regions and its effects on the corresponding ecosystem; 2) detailed observations of important flora and fauna comprising the Bering ecosystem; 3) response to predicted climate change; and, 4) flood hazards associated with ice dammed lakes. In additional efforts include: 1) a three day workshop on environmental research; 2) creation and storage of collected specimens in a searchable and accessible format; 3) development of a web site that provides stakeholders with access to research and data in this region; and 4) generation of a web accessible GIS.
